Association Celebrates Ten Years



It was September of 2004 when the first calls went out to find representatives from every Mount Vernon graduating class. Then in April of 2005, these people met for the very first time. Thirty-eight class representatives discussed the future of the Alumni Association, posed for the historical 'first picture,' then headed off to the ground-breaking ceremony for the new high school.

In the fall of 2005, they met again at Homecoming for the first Association Annual Meeting, with the goal of naming the first officers and a committee to form a document that would guide the organization. Since that time the By-Laws were completed and a host of alumni activities introduced.

These ten years also mark the maturity the Association has been able to achieve with its data-base development, continuing ideas about how alums can have a presence in the school district, the twice yearly alumni newsletter, its developing website presence, new Homecoming traditions and the Alumni Awards.

Treasurer Susan Mounts Fisher'65, one of our original board members, says "When we began, we weren't sure what our alums would want in terms of alumni activities, primarily social. We continually evaluate and continually try to improve. We are always open to suggestions. We have really appreciated both the volunteer and the financial support from our alumni, and

the support from the School District and Foundation. On our end we love the notes, the attendance, and the support that shows us we are going in the right direction. Sometimes we feel the way is a crooked road, but we just keep at it. If you have never attended an alumni breakfast, reception, or award event, I encourage you to soon. We have so much fun, and our alums are just the best! "

1981 MV Alum and former School District Board Member and Foundation Director, Bob Penn, who was an original proponent of forming the Alumni Association says

"I understood the deep value the Alumni Association would have from the beginning. As diverse as we all are we share a tremendous amount in common. Wherever our alumni live today we still like to connect with our roots and with each other.

We had no idea how truly grand the Association would become. The newsletters are spectacular. The Association boards and volunteers are amazing. The impact has reached further than anyone could have imagined. The School Foundation has benefitted. The greater community of Mount Vernon has benefitted.

The Association is more proof that exceeding expectations is a tradition with Mount Vernon students and alumni. I knew in my heart that other alumni felt the same way that I did



about our fellow graduates and our school. It's incredible to see what an organized energized bunch of folks have done with a simple idea. It's humbling to think that I get to be on the same team with them.

People from other school districts have asked me what we did as a school board to create such a great Alumni Association. The School Board can't take much credit. All we could do was share a vision and get out of the way. The reason we have such a quality Alumni Association is 100% correlated to the quality alumni who drive it. In 1988, school board member Dean Borg coined a phrase...while the phrase is only four words long to me it says it all. 'We are Mount Vernon.'"

1-2004 Discussions begin about alumni association

9-2004 Search to find class representatives begins. Meetings between individual class representatives and school staff take place to put data base into place. Representatives for approx 90% of classes since 1940 found.

Both an Alumni Web page on the District's website is created, and an online Alumni Data base is created -- an expansive and interactive database that includes alumni from 1930-to present day. Classes from 1879-1929 are listed separately on the Alumni Web site.

4-2005 1st Alumni Association Meeting for class representatives with 38 alums ranging from the class of 1940 to 2005.

5-2005 1st Alumni Newsletter is printed

7-2005 2nd Alumni representative meeting held to begin organization and discuss scope of Alumni Association. A By-Laws Committee is formed.

7-2005 Held 1st Heritage Days Breakfast and Reception

10-2005 Held our 1st Homecoming Reception

10-2005 1st Annual Meeting at Homecoming, approval of first By-Laws and our first board. Lisa Squiers White'88 is first Association President.

3-2007 The Alumni Association becomes sponsor for the High School Honor Society, providing volunteers & reception cake. Often an alum is the guest speaker.

12-2007 Inaugaral Alumni Awards are announced.

6-2008 Judy Penn'60 volunteers and becomes overseer of the Alumni Data Base.

10-2008 Association announced first Alumni Hall of Fame inductees at the school's Homecoming game on October 3rd. John Rife'60 is our Master of Ceremonies. Kevin Rogers'81 is named Association President.

10-2008 Alumni Band made their inaugural appearance

7-2009 The Association's oldest alum, Myrtle Westcott Licht'29, was present at Heritage Days

5-2010 May 2010 marked the "unofficial" official kick off of our five year anniversary. President Kevin Rogers'81 and Treasurer Susan Mounts Fisher'65 start tradition of presenting graduates with a Mount Vernon Alumni lapel pin

2-2013 An additional Alumni Award, the MVCSD Community Impact Award was added to the fall Hall of Fame awards

8-2014 Dennis Jordan is named President of the Association.


Organization of the Association


